Thanks for the opportunity to discuss Treasury OIG's review of the Department's plans for returning employees to their offices. As I said during our call yesterday, given our limited resources and CARES Act oversight responsibilities, we cannot take up a full-scope inquiry along the lines set out in Chairman Connolly's letter; however, we are planning to review the plans propounded by the Department, and its constituent bureaus and offices, which will establish the baseline of Treasury's response. We will obtain information about actions to safeguard workspaces and common areas and provide PPE and other protective material. We will request information about instances of employees testing positive for the virus, and evaluate planned responses to such test results. We will evaluate all hotline information and other employee input we receive, and use all of these data to

determine where problems exist, which programs and operations are at most risk, and concentrate further inquiries accordingly. We will keep you advised of developments.
